Felt Catalogue - Purpose made, professional woollen papermaking felts

All the "wet felts" listed here were made to demanding professional specifications. They were made entirely from high quality wool, woven in the traditional way with the nap raised with drums covered in teasels. When made they weighed 800 grams per square metre but are now lighter in weight which varies. They vary in shade from cream to beige/buff. All felts apart from F28 have been washed, rinsed and dried since they were last used. F28 are dusty and need washing. All the felts have been stored with mothballs (strongly recommended!).

Felts listed as Condition 1 were practically new. Condition 2 had had moderate use. All Condition 1 & 2 felts have been sold. Condition 3 have had considerable wear and the weave is beginning to show. "Pack felts" are either wet felts worn beyond Hayle Mill's usable limits or lighter weight felts made for the purpose - i.e. separating packs of wet paper from alloy plates when pack pressing. They may be useful for couching small sheets of paper.

Whilst these felts met high professional requirements I cannot guarantee them for any buyer's uses. In particular I can make no guarantee about their longevity as wool can be quickly ruined by biological deterioration arising from inadequate cleaning, drying or storage. Although new felts lasted for many years with careful use, Condition 3 & Pack felts will have shorter useful lives.

Felts should be washed and dried after use. Soap or detergent were not normally used at Hayle Mill, just fresh water at 40-50°C (100-120°F) and a small amount of biocide. BDH "Panacide" was used since Formaldehyde, which is very effective, can be a health hazard. Many years ago copper sulphate (which is poisonous) was used at the rate of 1 oz per 40 gallons of water. After rinsing several times the felts were hydraulically pressed and laid out to dry naturally. They have been stored in neat stacks with a few mothballs per hundred felts in moderate temperature & humidity. Before use, soaking with a hose followed by hydraulic pressing, produced just the right moisture content for couching. Apparently slight acidity is preferable to alkalinity to ensure long life so the use of alkaline cleaners such as ammonia could be damaging.
